## Charges dropped against dominatrix

Prostitution charges were dropped Monday against the so-called Bedford Dominatrix.

Sandra Chemero, 47, was arrested last February after a Westchester County undercover cop secretly taped a conversation with her at her Bedford Hills home.

A police raid at the home shocked the tony town, which is home to Martha Stewart, Chevy Chase, Glenn Close, Ralph Lauren and other celebrities.

"We heard nothing on those tapes that indicated Sandra was offering sexual services," said her lawyer George Galgano after Chemero's hearing Monday. "She is not a prostitute."

Chemero agreed to plead guilty to disorderly conduct for operating a business out of her home without a permit. She was charged with a violation and fined \$350. She was also ordered to spend 30 days of community service working at a local hospital.
